- Copies of certificates, diplomas and academic degree certificates of courses attended previously
- > The certificate of registration or a comparable certificate issued by the university confirming that you have been admitted as a regular student
- ➤ If applicable, copies of refusal letters received from other organisations
- > Copy of your national identity card or passport clearly showing your surname(s) and first name(s)
